



Spring

- Is there any frozen water that could melt and create a big mess now that it is getting warmer?
- Are my plants contained & healthy?
- Are there nearby rivers that could flood streets nearby my home now that snow is melting?
- Could my yard be flooded?
- Are drains around my house and on my property clogged?



Summer

- Is my fence working to keep my animals in?
- Are there any dog holes to fill?
- Are my sprinklers working?
- Do all of my fire alarms work?
- Is my AC functioning?
- How's the outside paint doing?



Fall

- Is my home ready for rain & mud?
- Am I ready to rake leaves?
- Are there any trees that could fall in a windstorm?
- Now that it is getting darker, are my porch lights working?
- Does my roof need some TLC?



Winter

- Is my home ready for rain, ice, snow, hail, mud, & freezing temperatures?
- Do my pipes need lagging?
- Is there unwanted frozen water?
- How's my hot water tank?
- Is my sidewalk/driveway/porch safe?
- Do I have a snow shovel & snow salt?
- Are all my heaters working 100%?

Above are just some good things to keep in mind. To always be as prepared, throughout the year, ask yourself:

1. What is the possible season weather in my area?
2. What basic weather safety precautions does my city take for all 4 seasons?
3. How does my house typically act each season?
4. Have I looked at weather warnings throughout this season?
5. What are the common seasonal hazard situations in my state, city, neighborhood?
6. What vulnerable house areas do I need to secure before the next season starts?
