## Going on a Summer Road Trip? Here are Some Car Preparation Tips!



The last thing you want is to get stuck on the side of some unfamiliar road while on vacation.

Help ensure that the vehicle you are taking is ready for the job:

- Check your fluids—oil, anti-freeze, transmission fluid, brake fluid, & windshield wiper fluid.
  - Need to top anything off?
  - Any leaks?
  - Going through any fluids at a fast rate (i.e., burning oil?)
- Check other items & functions on your car—tires, AC, windshield wipers, dashboard meters, headlights, turn signals, brake lights, brakes, etc.
- Need to do some general maintenance first? Such as: an oil change, air up tires, get a re-alignment, charge AC, get a tune up, etc.
- Need to pack some backup items? Spare tire, tire patch kit, tire pump, car jack, tire iron, jumper cable set, other basic tools, spare bulbs/fuses, check engine light code reader, backup fluids, first-aid kit, water & snacks, etc.

Have roadside assistance like AAA? See what services you have and if they will go to the areas you will be traveling. You never know when you might need a tow, jump start, gas, or tire repair. Some services can also open your door if you lock your keys in the car.

# Washington's Credit Score Ban

### What is happening?

WA Insurance Commissioner (OIC), Mike Kreidler, issued a 120-day temporary emergency order (effective June 20, 2021), prohibiting all insurance companies from using credit scores as a rating factor for insurance premiums for personal auto and home insurance. While the order is temporary, it may stay in effect for 3 years or more.

### What does this mean for me?

If you have a personal insurance policy in Washington, you may see an increase or decrease in premium when you go to renew after June 20, 2021. (You'll not see a change until you go to renew and/or you add a new policy.)

### How is Mosaic going to help me?

### Should I stay with my current carrier?

We'll recommend most clients to stay with their current provider. <u>It's about what will help you long-term.</u> It may be better for you to change to another provider, and if that is the case, we will shop around!

- Your carrier isn't the only one being impacted all personal auto and home Washington policies can no longer use credit scores.
- •The next 1-2 years are expected to be more stable. Insurance companies will continue to adapt to the credit change, figuring out new ways to help their customers get impacted less.
- Member longevity has been a significant insurance rating factor for years, and it's likely to impact discount factors more in the future. Staying with your carrier avoids resetting that "valued member" clock.

# Pandemic Pet Boom & Tips for Your Fur Babies

One of our insurance carriers, PEMCO Insurance, has found that pet ownership has grown substantially since the 1980s. They highlighted that in Washington alone (before the COVID-19 pandemic), 62.7% of homes have at least one pet. The coronavirus has led to a bigger rise in pet adoption.

#### We gathered tips that might help you out during these times:

- Did you get a new pet, or are you thinking about it?—
  Update your insurance! Talk to your agent and see what you need to do for your home/renters insurance. We recommend doing this beforehand. For exotic pets, or a breeds that tend to be restricted, reach out to us and we will see if any carriers we write with will take them.
- 2. Finding a vet. Some businesses have closed down since COVID, others have very restricted hours/services, and many are really booked up. If Google searches do not help you, cast a net over social media. Many local Facebook community pages will allow you to ask for recommendations that other members will answer.
- Be cautious with interaction. Red Cross recommends that you do not let people outside your household interact with your pets during this time.
- 1-on-1 Time. Like for us, the coronavirus has impacted pets' social lives. Try to give them as much 1-on-1 time as possible each day.



# Mint Chocolate Chip Ice Cream Recipe



July 18th was National Ice Cream Day, and here at Mosaic, we're a bunch of chocolate lovers! We did a poll, and the top loved flavor was mint chocolate chip, with almost all others having chocolate.

Here's a homemade mint chocolate ice cream recipe we found on Pinterest from Small Town Woman, written by Beth Pierce: www.smalltownwoman.com/mint-chocolate-chip-ice-cream/

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 2 cups half n half
- 2 cups whipping cream
- 1 cup sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla
- 1 1/2 teaspoons mint extract
- 4-5 drops green food coloring
- 3 ounces semisweet chocolate finely chopped
- l ounce milk chocolate finely chopped

#### STEPS:

- Whisk together half and half and sugar until the sugar is dissolved. Whisk in cream, vanilla extract, mint extract and a little bit of green food coloring if desired.
- Pour the contents into the bowl of your \*ice cream maker\* and follow the manufacturers instructions. After 20 minutes add the chopped chocolate. Churn for an additional 5-7 minutes before checking the ice cream as it is possible to over churn ice cream.
- Pour into a freezer container or loaf pan and store in the freezer.

\*Don't have an ice cream maker? Electronic mixers and ice cream balls can work too!\*
