#### **Pest Control This Summer**

- Pests avoid certain smells and plants. For example, spiders and ants don't like peppermint, cinnamon, tea tree, garlic, coffee grounds, or vinegar.
- •Spraying around doors and windows with vinegar and baking soda can help keep them at bay. (You might need to respray once a week.)

- Seal open snacks properly.

#### Prowlers Look For...

- Seclusion & darkness
- Visual items that appear valuable
- · Little or no cameras or witnesses · Cars that are easy to break into,
- steal, or remove parts from · Open windows, unlocked doors, or
- damages that hinder security

#### If Your Car Is Stolen/Broken Into...

- · Call police ASAP & file a report
- See if video footage/witnesses exist
- Contact insurance carrier ASAP
- · Consider mechanic review & give police & insurance the repair quotes
- · Have consistent communication, save any and all contact information, take notes, keep copies of files, & take lots of pictures/video

#### You Can Help Avoid Car Theft By...

Parking in areas with lighting, high population, cameras, & low crime

- Keeping your car clean
- · Concealing desirables (and not having them whenever possible)
- Rolling up windows & locking doors
- Keeping doors/trunks fully closed

#### What to Know About Insurance:

- Most comprehensive & full coverage will cover car theft & break-ins.
- · If your car was stolen & never recovered, both coverages should also cover actual cash value (ACV) of your car minus the deductible.
- · Some factors that are considered for ACV include: pre-loss condition, age, mileage, make, model, & year.

## Q: Do you have to insure your pool or trampoline by law?

A: Having your pool or trampoline insured means that if a covered loss occurs, your home insurance can help pay for damages/injuries. Technically. Washington has no law that requires you to have your pool or trampoline insured. But your home insurance company has its own regulations in place that you must follow to be covered. Some carriers do not allow pools or trampolines, and many have specific quidelines that must be followed. You must abide by the rules and regulations within your insurance policy, like with any contract.
