
- 2 Lane Road: Everyone Stops
- 3+ Lane Road: Stop if traveling the same direction.
- Turning Lane: Stop if traveling the same direction.
- Median/Barrier: Stop if traveling the same direction.




- Roundabouts (or traffic circles) are increasing in popularity. Also, it's common to encounter ones that look different, are different sizes, and have different amounts of lanes within the same city. We think that brushing up on how to drive in them before the dark, cold, and wet weather really sinks in is a great idea for all of us. Washington State Department of Transportation has tips and graphics for you and your friends **here**.
- 2. If you encounter ice or rain, be extra cautious with bridges, hills, turns, train tracks, braking, and accelerating. Also avoid driving through puddles if you can safely do so. More on that here.
- 3. Don't use cruise control when there is water on the roads. As **AAA explains**, driving through puddles while in cruise control can cause your car to accelerate. Using cruise control when there are puddles, wet roads, and/or ice can make your car hydroplane. Additionally, since cruise control is disabled by braking, it can also make you brake when you shouldn't.
- 4. Don't use your high beams in rain or fog—as described here, it can actually make it harder to see!
